Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

It has developed into a bi-lingual church where we have preaching in English Sunday morning, Spanish on Sunday night, and the majority rules on Wednesday night (to determine whether Spanish or English). We baptized three more in August and rejoice with them in obeying the Lord in their first step as believers. Please pray for Tania (the Nicaraguan lady that we reported getting saved in our last letter), Pepe (a Navy retiree saved back in April), and Zack. Zack is in the U.S. Air Force and he and his wife have been faithfully coming for a few months now. He came to us already saved, but after studying the Scriptures on his own, he realized that he had not been baptized the Bible way – by immersion. He asked me to help him obey the Lord and I gladly obliged.

I recently spoke with the men of our church and shared with them my vision to begin to branch out to nearby cities and start new churches. They were overwhelmingly in support of the plan and very enthusiastic. After the meeting, one of the men shared with me that he believes the Lord is calling him to be a missionary and is seeking the Lord's will as to where. I am asking you, our prayer warriors and supporters, to fervently pray and ask the Lord to open doors unto us and allow us to get more works started. We know that He is the One that will build it and we are thankful that He is giving us opportunity to have a part in it.

We thank the Lord for bringing Patsy home and helping me in her absence. I learned a valuable lesson as to just how much my wife does and how much more I need her. Praise God for a wonderful helpmeet. Several churches generously helped us with travel expenses and we want to praise the Lord for your love and prayers. She is recuperating well and running at full speed. She recently began teaching a quilting class and we have seen some new prospects because of it. Please pray for this outreach and ask the Lord to give us fruit through it.

We specifically request your prayers concerning one the Spanish ladies in our church, Ana Lilia, who is expecting triplets. She is at six months and we are asking the Lord to give her safe delivery of three baby girls.
